<b>Graffiti – Council Owned Infrastructure Only</b> - 4 <sup>th</sup> week of the Month or by request  Graffiti inspection and cleaning. Make a RFS for graffiti removal (see process pg 2)								
<b>Pot Plant Maintenance</b> - 3 <sup>rd</sup> week of the month or by request  Single man crew's maintenance runs- These are carried out on a 3-week cycle with maintenance & watering.  There is a regular watering cycle that is done. Through winter months, it drops down as there is a lot of rain, but is still carried out as some pots are under cover, however as we come into spring it is usually carried out on a weekly basis and in the warmer summer months can be done as often as 2 to 3 times a week.								
<b>Christmas Decorations</b> - Annually: 1 <sup>st</sup> Thursday in November until 2 <sup>nd</sup> week in January – Pole Decorations & Bin Surrounds  Each year Council (Depot) installs Christmas decorations across the municipality in the form of Bin Wraps and Pole Decorations.  Economic Development assist with decorations in areas that are not part of a Special Rate Scheme eg. Mt Alexander Road, Napier Street Essendon, Centre Way - Keilor East, Milleara Road, Avondale Heights.								
<b>Local Laws</b>  Local Laws administer Footpath Trading and Car Parking  <b>Parking</b>  Parking officers enforce parking restrictions under the Road Safety Act & Regulations and promote, educate by advising the community on matters related to parking and compliance matters.								

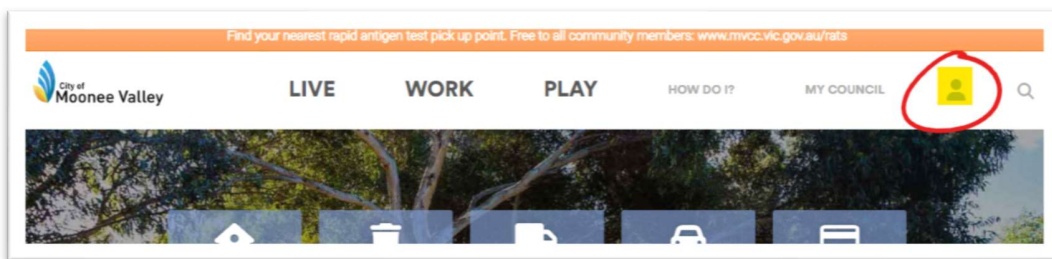
## Economic Development

Economic Development attend trader meetings and act as a conduit to assist with Activity Centre enquiries across Council.

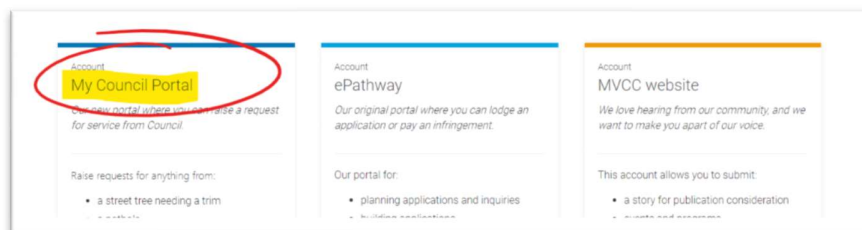
They also support all events and programs run by the Trader Associations.
